2.	The reasons for the selection of the candidate. Selection shall be with reference to the qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate, and not mere "winnability" at the polls (not more than 100 words)	The candidate, who is a Post Graduate in Political Science, and also holds a Degree in Law, was in active student politics till 1986 and since then has been leading the labour movement in the State. He is devoted to the cause of building & other construction workers, workers in the unorganized sector, and actively involved in the holistic welfare of slum dwellers, street vendors and rickshaw pullers. His dedication to public welfare and the leadership he has given to the downtrodden sections of the society, were the reasons for his selection to the post.

Reasons as to why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates (not more than 100 words)	Considering the above stated merits for his selection as a candidate and the cases being entirely of a political nature in the matter of leading demonstrations, processions and protests as a leader of the poor people, were the reasons for preferring him over others as a candidate. Rajya Sabha being the august House of distinguished representatives and considering his eminence as a distinguished person of the State, his selection to the Rajya Sabha in comparison to others was obvious.

Note:-

- (1) Political parties (ast the Central and State election level) shall upload on their website detailed information regarding individuals with pending criminal cases (including the nature of the offences, and relevant particulars such as shether charges have been framed, the concerned Court, the case number etc.) who have been selected as candidates, along with the reasons for such selection, as also as to why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates.
- (2) The reasons as to selection shall be with reference to the qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate concerned, and not mere "winnability" at the polls.
- (3) This information shall also be published in :
 - (a) One local vernacular newspaper and one national newspaper;
 - (b) On the officials social media platfrms of the political party, including Facebook * Twitter.
- (4) The matter in newspapers shall be published in font size of at leas 12.
- (5) The above information shall be published State wise for each State/UT.
- (6) **These details shall be published within 48 hours of the selection of the candidate or not less than two weeks before the first date for filing of nominations, whichever is earlier.**
- (7) **The political party concerned shall then submit a report of compliance in Format C-8 with the Election Commission within 72 hours of the selection of the said candidate.**
